All-School Rollerskating Unit in PE Classes

All PE classes have a rollerskating unit for two weeks, January 22-February 2. We have a company who specializes in providing roller skates to use on our gym floor. No outside skates will be permitted in order to protect our floor.

We ask for \$5 per student for this unit. The Traver Community Club pays the other half to keep costs low for families. If the money is a hardship for your family, please let us know. No child will be denied participation because of cost. Permission slips will go home in January.

5th Grade Ski Trips in Early February

The fifth grade goes to Grand Geneva each year to learn how to ski. The students go 3 times in the afternoon of school days and return to catch their regular transportation home.

All students are supervised by both Grand Geneva staff and our staff. They receive lessons and wear helmets for added protection. All equipment can be rented. Students just need to wear warm gear. Permission slips from The Mountaintop at Grand Geneva (the ski hill) must be completed. Forms will go home early January.

We ask families contribute \$30 for their student for the activity. (Traver Community Club and the school pay the other \$65 per student plus bus costs.) If the money is a hardship for your family, please let us know. No child will be denied participation because of cost.

READING CHALLENGE UPDATE

This year's challenge is to make a paper chain of books stretch across the gym! The students have made reading goals and are adding a new link to the chain when they finish a book. This challenge is open to all students and staff who want to participate.

Some students' goals are more challenging than others, depending on their age and what they think they can do. The books can be from school or elsewhere and are of the students' choosing—we are just happy that they are reading!

Our next goal: Trimester 2 Recognition Program will include recognizing the students who made at least half their goal. (Trimester 3 recognition will be the students who complete their goal.) The whole school, regardless of participation, will win a school prize if we meet the challenge!
