Summer is around the corner. That brings lots of emotions for both kids and parents—some good, some not so good.

Our staff can tell when big breaks away from school are near. A few days or weeks before break we see more dysregulation and strong emotional reactions. We notice that kids tend to get in trouble more before breaks. We also see anxiety and worry in some kids.

Check in with your kids everyday:

- Waking up— Allow yourself 1-2 minutes to spend with your child each morning at wake up. If your child wakes themself up, find the opportunity to connect with them about their day at some point.
- *Pep talks* Make sure your child hears positive words before you see them go for the day. If you know they are struggling with something, give them a specific pep talk about handling the day.
