Name	Criteria
Academic Perseverance (Trimester 1)	<ul> <li>Grades 4K-8</li> <li>Teachers are allowed to award no more than 2 per caseload</li> <li>Specialists are allowed to award no more than 2 per elementary caseload and no more than 2 per middle school caseload</li> <li>Given in these subjects: Art, Band, Health, Language Arts, Mathematics, Music, Physical Education, Science, Social Studies, Spanish, Technology</li> <li>Students may only earn one recognition in one subject</li> <li>Students are chosen at the discretion of the teacher on: study habits, using time wisely, homework completion, engagement, giving best effort, etc.</li> </ul>
Math Masters (Trimesters 1, 2, 3)	<ul> <li>Grades 1-8</li> <li>Students earn by completing a level: addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, skip counting, fractions.</li> <li>Students in grades 1-4 my earn a recognition for re-mastering an operation from the previous year during Trimester 1, as teachers recognize "summer slide" can cause students to need to re-master.</li> </ul>
Forward Growth (Trimester 1)	<ul> <li>Grades 5-8 (Test results from previous spring)</li> <li>Students earn by improving a level on the state Forward test from the previous year in math and/or reading.</li> <li>Ex: Student takes the Forward in 3rd grade and 4th grade and improves a level from one year to the next. Recognition is given in 5th grade because test results are not received until the next year.</li> </ul>
Forward Excellence (Trimester 1)	<ul> <li>Grades 4-8</li> <li>Students who earn "proficient" or "advanced" on the state Forward test from the previous year in math and/or reading.</li> <li>For 4th graders (now 5th graders), Science and Social Studies as well</li> </ul>
Extracurricular Participation	<ul> <li>Cross Country runners, grades 1-8 (Tri 1)</li> <li>Girls' Volleyball team, grades 4-8 (Tri 1)</li> <li>Girls' Basketball team, grades 4-8 (Tri 2)</li> <li>Boys' Basketball team, grades 4-8 (Tri 2)</li> <li>Spelling Bee, grades 3-8 classroom and school winners (Tri 2)</li> <li>Quiz Bowl, grade 6 (Tri 2)</li> <li>Art Show winners (if any) (Tri 3)</li> <li>Forensics winners (if any) (Tri 3)</li> <li>Solo &amp; Ensemble contest, grades 6-8 (Tri 3)</li> <li>Track Meet awards (Tri 3)</li> </ul>
Reading Challenge (Trimesters 2-3)	<ul> <li>Grades 4K-8</li> <li>Students set personal goals for how many books they think they can read.</li> <li>Students are recognized Tri 2 for meeting their halfway point.</li> <li>Students are recognized Tri 3 for meeting their goal.</li> </ul>

Academic Growth (Trimesters 1 and 3)	<ul> <li>Grades 1-8</li> <li>Students earn by improving their progress monitoring scores in math and/or reading:</li> <li>Tri 1: improving their score from previous spring in former grade to new grade level in the fall of the new year</li> <li>Tri 3: improving their score from fall to spring of the same school year</li> </ul>
Academic Excellence (Trimesters 1-3)	<ul> <li>Grades 1-8 Tri 2; Grades 5K-8 Tri 3</li> <li>Students earn recognition if scores are 85th percentile or higher on the progress monitoring scores in math and/or reading</li> </ul>
Citizenship (Trimester 2)	<ul> <li>Grades 4K-8</li> <li>Teachers vote to nominate students from each class.</li> <li>Students vote from the teacher nominations.</li> <li>Must show respect for others, excellence in themselves and the school, persevere in their schoolwork, and participate in the school community through activities and events.</li> </ul>
Leader of the Pack (Trimester 3)	<ul> <li>Grade clusters: 3-4, 5-6, 7-8</li> <li>No more than 1 student per grade cluster. It is possible to have no student in any given grade cluster.</li> <li>Students may only earn this recognition once.</li> <li>Teachers vote to nominate students from each class.</li> <li>Students vote from the teacher nominations each trimester.</li> <li>In the event of a tie, teachers will vote to break.</li> <li>The student who earns the most votes throughout the year earns the award.</li> <li>Students who earn this award exemplify all Traver Traits: respect, excellence, community, integrity, perseverance, empathy.</li> </ul>
